Definitions

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are
 called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing
 employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved
 postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the
 applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the
 institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an
 examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination
 available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

You may cancel your contract for school, without any penalty or obligations until the close of the seventh business day following your first class session. Student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment whichever is later. Cancellation of the contract will occur when you have submitted a written notice of cancellation to the school at the address shown on the front page of this Enrollment Agreement. A signed and dated notice of cancellation may be given by mail or hand delivery. The notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed with postage prepaid. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, is effective if it states that a student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement. If you cancel your Enrollment Agreement, you will receive a refund of all monies paid within 30 days of cancellation, less registration fee. You have the right to cancel the enrollment agreement including any equipment purchased directly from Westchester College such as books, materials, and supplies or any other goods related to the instruction offered in the enrollment agreement, if notice of cancellation is made within seven (7) calendar days (excluding holidays) of enrollment or by the seventh (7th) calendar day following the scheduled program start date. whichever is later. Books purchased from Westchester College must be returned to the school in "like new" condition within the cancellation period, or students will be liable for the full cost. Within 10 days of the day on which the refund is made, the institution will notify the student in writing of the date on which the refund was made, the amount of the refund, the method of calculating the refund, and the name and address of the entity to which the refund was sent. If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.
